MESSAGE FOR OUR MEMBERS

As this extraordinary situation continues to evolve, we're doing everything we can to support our members and provide the services that you need.

At the same time, Caboolture and District Bowmen are responding quickly by changing the way we do things to keep our members safe.

We're keeping it clean and practising good hygiene

- We have installed an automatic hand sanitizer dispenser near the front counter as well as hand soap and anti-bacterial wipes in the toilets and the sink at the back of the clubhouse.

We've made some changes to keep you safe

We will be opening the grounds for PRACTICE ONLY from this coming Saturday 23rd of May, with the following restrictions in place, that MUST be adhered to by ALL members attending the grounds.

- All attendees MUST be a Financial Member of the Club. If you need to renew your membership, the form is available on Facebook, via your Email or on our Webpage. Please note that we now have Credit/Debit card facilities to make processing your membership more streamlined. We are not accepting cash at the moment.

- We can only allow a maximum of 20 people on the grounds at any one time.

- o 6 on practice butts (using marked lanes)

- o 14 on practice range (maximum of 3 per group)

If you arrive and you are the 21st person, please wait in your car until someone leaves.

- Please ensure that you lock the gate when you arrive and when you leave to minimise walk-ins / drive ins. Front gate MUST be locked AT ALL TIMES.

- Sign in and out of grounds using the Contact Tracing Information Sign on Sheet. Please bring your own pen.

- Do not share Equipment

- Pull your own arrows

- Use disinfectant wipes/spray provided in bathrooms to clean before and after use

- Practice hand hygiene (sanitizer and soap provided).

- Practice Social Distancing

- Read, understand and follow all signage relating to COVID-19 restrictions.

- If you feel unwell, have a fever, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath, DO NOT enter the Club Grounds. Stay Home!
